This Saturday September 9, gives all of us the opportunity to visit a burial place or a memorial site and recall how those children got there, and how much still needs to be done to save the innocent lives of unborn children. Visiting a gravesite or memorial site for aborted children offers hope and healing to the women, the fathers, and the grandparents who have been hurt, and are still grieving for their unborn child.
