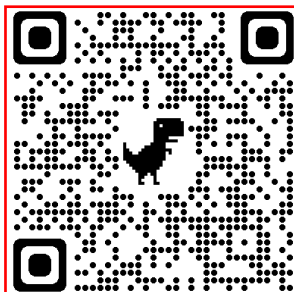

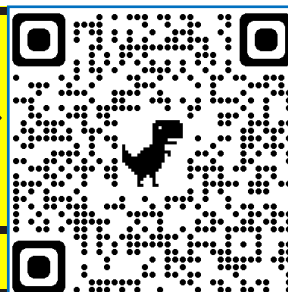

Myra, the Sustaining the Family Table Case Manager, has been working with St Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church for the last four years and we are so grateful that they have chosen this amazing CPO program to provide a joyful Christmas to deserving families! There were 5 families that were chosen this year with a total of 6 kids that received clothes, a toy, diapers and a gift card for each parent.

This youth group's "Adopt-a-Family" event is a service project for St Luke's youths/teens. They earn and contribute their own money (each youth/teen is asked to earn and bring at least \$5-\$10) and the money is pooled. They meet one Sunday to shop, and the youths/teens are divided into small groups with each group being given one child to buy gifts.



When delivering some of the gifts, the families have expressed how they could not imagine how they would have been able to even have Christmas and some of the families cried with tears of joy! The Sustaining the Family Table UW Collaborative and St Luke Catholic Church have been the answers to these families prayers this Christmas!

We have had several parishioners test these, including some of our seniors. They tell us that the earpieces provide excellent enhanced sound.
