## A Note to Sponsors

#### Dear Confirmation Sponsor,

Congratulations on the honor of being asked to accompany one of St. Luke's candidates as they enter a deeper relationship with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Your candidate searched for someone who loves Jesus and the Catholic Church and whose life bears the fruit of that love. They considered who would teach them who Jesus is and how to live in relationship with Him. Knowing that they needed to be comfortable sharing with a sponsor, your candidate discerned who they could trust. **And they chose you.** 

There is no recipe for being a perfect sponsor. At St. Luke, we do not have a program or activities for you to do together because we desire this sacred relationship to be guided by the Holy Spirit. Please meet with your candidate at least monthly for their two years of formation – this is a time commitment, and a very worthy one. Pray with (and for) your candidate. Encourage them to pray out loud and from the heart. Lead them close to our Lord in the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Reconciliation. Receive these Sacraments alongside them, witnessing to them that your faith is for real. You know your candidate well; lead them in activities that will interest them. Read Scripture, lead them in different ways to pray, watch informational videos or The Chosen, read books, listen to podcasts, and talk about all of it. Let them ask questions and share their excitement, revelations, boredom, confusion, or doubts. Listen without judgment and help them lean into Catholic Teaching. You are making a lasting impact on your candidate's life.
