

Reflection on Pentecost Sunday

The season of Easter concludes with today's celebration, the feast of Pentecost. On Pentecost we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles gathered in the upper room in Jerusalem; this event marks the beginning of the Church. The story of Pentecost is found in the Acts of the Apostles, today's first reading. The account in today's Gospel, John 20:19-23, also recounts how Jesus gave the gift of the Holy Spirit to his disciples. Yet the event in John's Gospel takes place on Easter Sunday. There is no need to try to reconcile these two accounts. After his death, Jesus fulfilled his promise to send to his disciples a helper, an Advocate, who would enable them to be his witnesses throughout the world.

In the context of the feast of Pentecost, John 20:19-23 reminds us about the integral connection between the gifts of peace and forgiveness and the action of the Holy Spirit. Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace. Jesus then commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun: "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." He breathes the Holy Spirit upon the disciples and sends them to continue his work of reconciliation through the forgiveness of sins. Jesus' act of breathing the Holy Spirit upon the apostles mirrors God's act of breathing life into Adam. In fact, both the Greek and Hebrew words for "spirit" can also be translated as "breath." This Gospel reminds us that the Church is called to be a reconciling presence in the world.



They are very easy to use.





What are the Qualities of True Sacred Music? #3: Universality

This week, we will go over the third and last quality of true sacred music: **universality**. As a preface to Pius X's words, let's briefly consider the term "Catholic." Catholic means "universal" (Greek *katholikós*, "universal" or "according to the whole"). Anything that is true, good, or beautiful is, in a real sense, Catholic. So when as Catholics we encounter new cultures, people, and ideas, we have within our Catholic worldview the ability to glean that which is best in each

culture and see it in some sense as our own, as something that is profoundly Catholic. Now on to Pius X:

"It must, at the same time, be universal in the sense that while every nation is permitted to admit into its ecclesiastical compositions those special forms which may be said to constitute its native music, still these forms must be subordinated in such a manner to the general characteristics of sacred music that nobody of any nation may receive an impression other than good on hearing them." (Pius X, Tra le Sollecitudini, § 2)

When it comes to adapting native music into sacred music, Pius X says it must follow the characteristics of sacred music we have already talked about, namely **sanctity** and **goodness of forms**. When music is selected and adapted to possess sanctity and goodness of forms, the last quality of **universality** will arise out of the former two. Music that is holy and excellent will have a truly universal appeal. That doesn't mean everyone will immediately love it, but it does mean that the initial impression will tend to be a good one, one that uplifts the soul rather than lowers it.

A high standard, to be sure. Please pray for the St. Luke's music ministry as we take on this noble task of providing for the worship of God music that is holy, beautiful, and universal.


Courage is a Roman Catholic apostolate which ministers to persons, both men and women, who experience same-sex attractions and desire support to live the Catholic Church's
