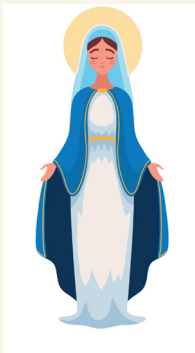

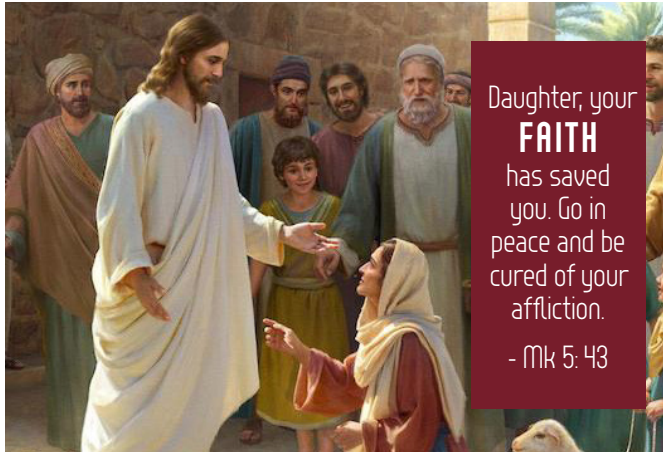

## Reflection on the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

For today’s Gospel, we continue to read from the Gospel of Mark. Last Sunday we heard about Jesus calming the storm, the first of four miracles that Jesus performs in the vicinity of the Sea of Galilee. Each of these four miracle stories offers us a glimpse at Jesus’ power. This week we hear about the third and fourth miracles, skipping the second miracle, the healing of a man from Gerasene who was possessed by a demon.

Today’s Gospel reports two stories of healing. One story tells us about a man named Jairus and his great love for his dying daughter. The other story tells us about a desperate woman who risks much as she seeks healing from Jesus. In each story, the request for healing is itself a courageous act of faith, and yet very different circumstances are represented by the lives of each suffering person.

The contrasts between Jairus and the woman with the hemorrhage are stark and revealing. One is a man, the other is a woman. One is a public official, an important person in the community. The other is a woman who has lost everything to find a cure to a condition that separated her from the community. One approaches Jesus publicly. The other approaches Jesus secretly. Yet in each case, faith leads them to seek out Jesus in their time of need.

## SAINTS FUN FACTS

Bl. Junipero Serra was born on the island of Majorca in 1713. He became a Franciscan and traveled to Mexico in 1750 where he spent the rest of his life. He was a large part of the foundation and spread of the Church in the western USA. He founded 21 missions and converted thousands of Indians. He taught the converts about agriculture, cattle raising and arts and crafts. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1988.

## Use of Organ at Mass

Do you ever wonder why we use pipe organ for Mass? Here are three of the most recent papal/conciliar statements on the instrument:

**1955** - "Among the musical instruments that have a place in church the organ rightly holds the principal position, since it is especially fitted for the sacred chants and sacred rites. It adds a wonderful splendor and a special magnificence to the ceremonies of the Church. It moves the souls of the faithful by the grandeur and sweetness of its tones. It gives minds an almost heavenly joy and it lifts them up powerfully to God and to higher things."

(Pius XII, *Musicae Sacrae*, 58)

**1963** - "In the Latin Church the pipe organ is to be held in high esteem, for it is the traditional musical instrument which adds a wonderful splendor to the Church's ceremonies and powerfully lifts up man's mind to God and to higher things."

(Vatican II, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, 120)

**1967** - "In sung or said Masses, the organ, or other instrument legitimately admitted, can be used to accompany the singing of the choir and the people; it can also be played solo at the beginning before the priest reaches the altar, at the Offertory, at the Communion, and at the end of Mass."

(Vatican II, *Musicam Sacram*, 65)

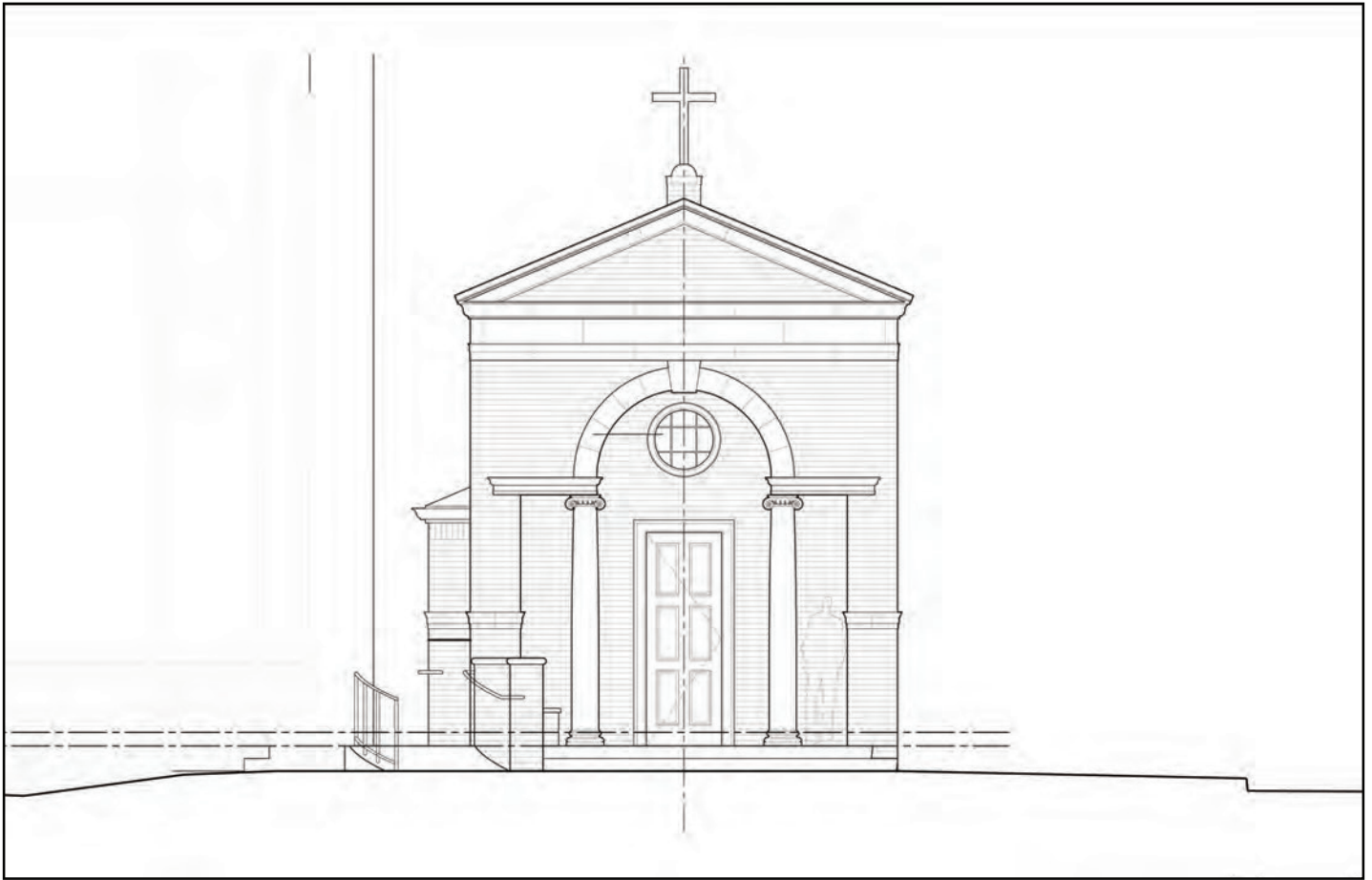
### Nine Month Novena Requested by Cardinal Burke
