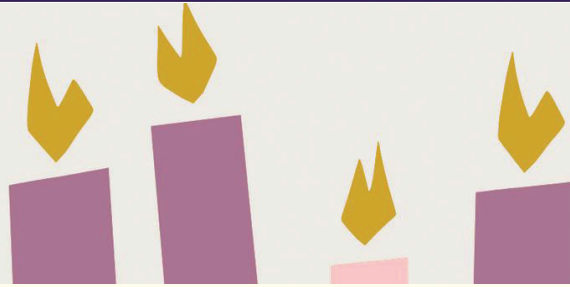

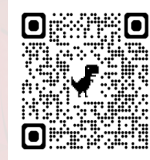

If you have an IRA, then you may be able to make a NON-TAXABLE donation to CPO, a 501(c)(3) charity, from your retirement account by making a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). Your QCD can qualify as part of your annual Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) but you won't have to pay income taxes on it! To save on your 2024 taxes, **you must do your QCD before December 31**. 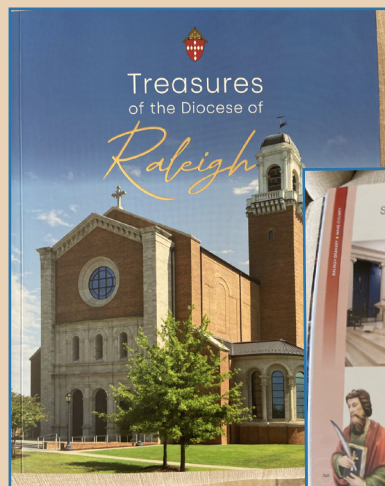

The cost is \$100 per seat, and school-age children ride free with a parent or guardian. The bus will leave from St. Raphaels Catholic Church and return the same day.


