



We are pleased to announce that as of August 1st, Rebecca Grant, our Director of Faith Formation and Youth Ministry, is stepping more fully into her role as Director of Faith Formation. In her four years at St. Luke, Rebecca has provided opportunities to our children through Vacation Bible School and the Word of Life series for Faith Formation and to our adults through Walking with Purpose and The Evangelical Catholic's "Reach More" partnership. She is excited for the challenge of growing our child and adult formation programs and to develop our Sacramental Preparation programs into deeper encounters with Christ.

We are excited for the changes and growth happening here at St. Luke, and we thank you for your continued prayers during this time of transition!
