

As part of our continued effort to make sure everyone has a good listening experience during Mass we wanted to make you aware that we now have several new Assisted Listening Devices.

They are very easy to use.

You basically put the earpiece on your ear, turn the little device on, and adjust the volume to your liking. Several parishioners have also found that their personal earbuds plug into the devices and work really well.

They are available at each Mass by simply asking one of our Ministers of Hospitality to get one for you.

We have had several parishioners test these, including some of our seniors. They tell us that the earpieces provide excellent enhanced sound.



Biking For Babies

Hello! my name is Jessica Kantra and I am a missionary with an organization called Biking for Babies. As a missionary with them, I seek to promote a culture of life by riding my bike over 600 miles in one week. This year, over 80 missionaries will be riding on one of eight different routes, finishing in either St. Louis, MO or Washington DC. As for myself, I will be leading a team from Columbus, OH to our Nation's Capital.



As we train & ride, we strive to raise awareness for pregnancy resource centers (PRCS). PRCs are places where women experiencing unplanned or crisis pregnancies can go to find support, free medical care (such as ultra sounds/checkups), supplies, counseling and more. Some PRCs even continue to work with these women for up to 3 years following the birth of their child in an effort to help them transition into life with a child with as little stress as possible.

Part of my job & the mission of Biking for Babies is to fundraise for our specific PRC so that they can continue providing women with extraordinary care, enabling them to feel confident choosing life over death.

The PRC I am paired with is Hand of Hope right here here in Raleigh. My goal is to raise \$2500 for them - last year I raised a little under \$4000, and I would love to surpass that total this year.

I would love it if you would join me on this vital mission by giving of your treasure while I give of my time, bringing all of your intentions with me as I continue my training & even through the week of the National Ride.


