



Bl. Junipero Serra was born on the island of Majorca in 1713. He became a Franciscan and traveled to Mexico in 1750 where he spent the rest of his life. He was a large part of the foundation and spread of the Church in the western USA. He founded 21 missions and converted thousands of Indians.

He taught the converts about agriculture, cattle raising and arts and crafts. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1988.

## Triangle-Area Young Adults Saturday Hike and Lunch


