

Attached is the new altar serving schedule that starts this weekend. Please remember that if you are not able to serve as scheduled, please send an email to as@stlukesraleigh.org to request a substitute ASAP. Some servers are not yet able to return to serving yet due to the COVID virus or vacations so some of you may be serving more often than normal. I did my best to accommodate everyone's time off requests.

Please remember the following when serving with Msgr. Ingham:

1. When bringing the vessels to the altar at offertory, take the chalice with the chalice veil to the altar for Msgr. Ingham or Deacon Mike to remove the veil and fold. Then you can return it to the credence table to be brought out later after communion when the vessels are brought back to the credence table.
2. The Roman Missal will **not** be on the altar at the beginning of mass as done recently with Father Rob. The Roman Missal will be brought to Msgr. for prayers before the Liturgy of the Word (at end of the Gloria) and after communion for the final prayer. This is the same as done in the past at St. Luke.
3. We are now helping the priest by holding a gold paten between the priest and those receiving communion. When done, give the paten(s) to the priest for purifying with the other communion vessels.
